The aim is to try and place as little waste in this container as possible.

A general waste container is for:

non-recyclables

packaging/polystyrene

food waste



plastic bags and wrappers



unknown plastics

Dry Mixed Recycling (DMR)

A convenient and space saving option for recycling. All containers for recycling must be empty or rinsed out.

A dry mixed recycling container is for:

- paper and cardboard
- drinks cans and food tins
- plastics bottles and containers:

Glass Recycling

To make this process easier we provide a mixed glass recycling service allowing for all colours of glass. Heat proof glass (e.g. Pyrex) cannot be recycled.

All glass that is empty and rinsed out can go
in the red bin bag
